From Tom's Galley Ginger Garlic Chicken Nuggets



In a large bowl combine garlic, ginger, lemon juice, oil, honey, turmeric, and cumin.

Add chicken nuggets and mix well to coat all chicken pieces. Transfer chicken and mixture to a zip-loc bag and marinate in refrigerator for a few hours to overnight.

1 pound boneless, skinless chicken breasts, cut

4 cloves garlic,	\Box 1/2 tsp. turmeric
minced	powder
1 1/2 tablespoon	☐ 1 tsp. cumin
ground ginger	☐ Cooking Spray
1 tablespoon lemon	☐ 1 bag Marie Caller
juice	ders Honey Butter
1 tablespoon of	Corn Bread Mix

Preheat oven to 400°.

Lightly spray baking sheet with cooking spray.

Place half of the corn bread mix in a large bowl. Add chicken nuggets, mix and toss to coat all chicken well.

Place chicken nuggets on baking sheet in a single layer. Cook for 8 minutes.

Flip nuggets over and cook an additional 5 to 6 minutes until lightly browned.

Serve with lemon yogurt mustard dip

Ingredients

- ☐ 1 cup lemon Greek yogurt
- ☐ 2 green onions, green ends finely chopped
- ☐ 1/2 teaspoon garlic powder
- ☐ 1 tablespoon honey Dijon mustard
- ☐ Salt to taste

Combine all ingredients and refrigerate 1 hour or more.

Stir and serve with chicken nuggets.



From Tom's Galley Cauliflower Crusted Alfredo Shrimp Pizza



Ingredients

☐ 1 Trader Joes Cauliflower Pizza Crust ☐ 1 red bell pepper 4 green onions 4 mushrooms □ 8 16-20 count shrimp ☐ 1 tablespoon butter, divided in half ☐ 2 tablespoons Philadelphia smoked salmon cream cheese ☐ 1/4 cup Trader Joe's Alfredo sauce ☐ 1/2 package imitation crab chunks ☐ 1/2 cup Trader Joe's Parmesan, Romano, Asiago cheese ☐ 2 tablespoons capers in vinegar

☐ 1/4 cup sliced black

olives, drained

Preheat oven to 450°.

Place frozen cauliflower crust on a rack on a baking sheet and bake according to package instructions.

Let crust cool for 10 minutes.

Core, seed and dice red pepper, set aside.

Slice green onions, including the green end, into 1/16 inch slices, set aside.

Slice mushrooms into 1/16 inch thick slices, set aside.

Peel and devein shrimp, slice in half lengthwise, set aside.

In a skillet over medium heat melt ½ tablespoon butter.

Add bell pepper, onions and mushrooms and sauté until just starting to soften, about 5 minutes. Remove to bowl and set aside.

Add second half of butter and sauté shrimp, turning, until just starting to turn opaque, about 2 minutes. Transfer to a bowl and set aside.

Spread salmon cream cheese evenly on pizza crust to ½ inch from the edge.

Spread Alfredo sauce evenly over top of salmon cream cheese. Top with imitation crab chunks.

Top with cheese mixture. Top cheese with pepper, onion, mushrooms. Top evenly with sliced olives.

Sprinkle evenly with capers. Place shrimp on top, cut side down. Lightly sprinkle with additional cheese.

Place on baking sheet and return to oven until topping is hot and melted, about 10 - 15 minutes.

Let cool for 5 minutes before cutting.







Viewing From The Yacht Club






