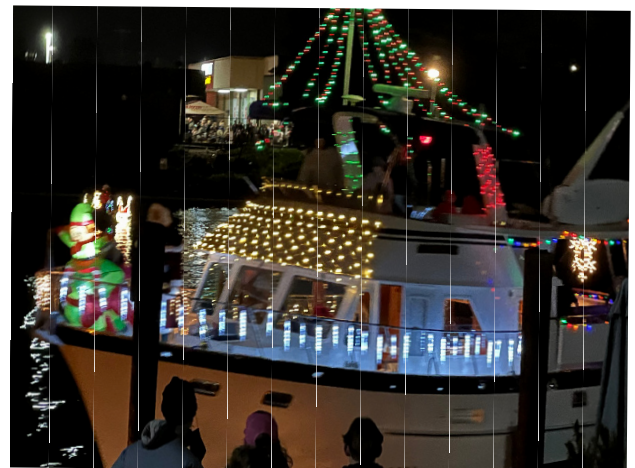

Cauliflower Crusted Alfredo Shrimp Pizza



Ingredients

- ☐ 1 Trader Joe's Cauliflower Pizza Crust
- ☐ 1 red bell pepper
- ☐ 4 green onions
- ☐ 4 mushrooms
- ☐ 8 16-20 count shrimp
- ☐ 1 tablespoon butter, divided in half
- ☐ 2 tablespoons Philadelphia smoked salmon cream cheese
- ☐ 1/4 cup Trader Joe's Alfredo sauce
- ☐ 1/2 package imitation crab chunks
- ☐ 1/2 cup Trader Joe's Parmesan, Romano, Asiago cheese
- ☐ 2 tablespoons capers in vinegar
- ☐ 1/4 cup sliced black olives, drained



Preheat oven to 450°.

Place frozen cauliflower crust on a rack on a baking sheet and bake according to package instructions.

Let crust cool for 10 minutes.

Core, seed and dice red pepper, set aside.

Slice green onions, including the green end, into 1/16 inch slices, set aside.

Slice mushrooms into 1/16 inch thick slices, set aside.

Peel and devein shrimp, slice in half lengthwise, set aside.

In a skillet over medium heat melt 1/2 tablespoon butter.

Add bell pepper, onions and mushrooms and sauté until just starting to soften, about 5 minutes. Remove to bowl and set aside.

Add second half of butter and sauté shrimp, turning, until just starting to turn opaque, about 2 minutes. Transfer to a bowl and set aside.

Spread salmon cream cheese evenly on pizza crust to 1/2 inch from the edge.

Spread Alfredo sauce evenly over top of salmon cream cheese. Top with imitation crab chunks.

Top with cheese mixture. Top cheese with pepper, onion, mushrooms. Top evenly with sliced olives.

Sprinkle evenly with capers. Place shrimp on top, cut side down. Lightly sprinkle with additional cheese.

Place on baking sheet and return to oven until topping is hot and melted, about 10 - 15 minutes.

Let cool for 5 minutes before cutting.

California Boater Card

If you are 40 years old or under in 2021 you are required to have obtained a **CALIFORNIA BOATER CARD** if you operate a vessel in open or lake waters in California, unless they meet certain exemptions. By 2025 all California boaters will be required to have a California boater card. Boat operators cited without a boater card may receive a fine of up to \$100 for the conviction, \$250 for the second and \$500 for the third. To obtain your California Boater Card click on this <https://www.boaterexam.com/usa/california/> The cost is \$10.00 to register and \$29.95 for the training program and Certification Card. You can stop and start the online course making it convenient for everyone



PYC Membership Report

As of this writing, there is one non-boat owning membership whose annual dues we are awaiting. Therefore we don't have a final membership count for the coming year. Assuming this remaining membership gets paid, here is an interim update. We received notice that boat owners Chris Keegan and Darby Tarantino have resigned and after removing them and those previously known to have departed, including Pauls, Comstock, Hamiltons and Freemans and adding the approved Symons, our ratio of boat-owning members to total memberships will be $56/82=68.29\%$. If the one membership does not pay their dues they will be ejected and the ratio will be $56/81=69.14\%$.

Either way, this will allow me to propose the Neidels (who have attended both meetings) for approval at our board meeting. They will resubmit their check since it was returned to them. Next on the list is Charles Dollwet who has not attended meetings but I'll ask him to resubmit his check so he can be eligible to attend future meetings.

As we learn the final results of paid memberships we will update the roster, the members.petalumayachtclub.com website and the email list.

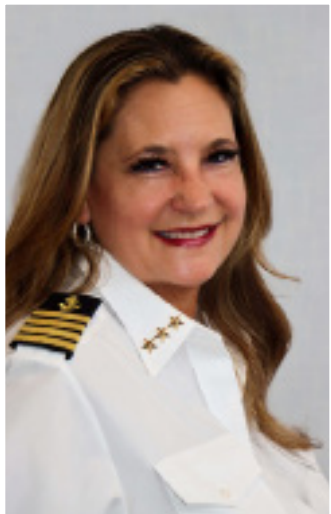
